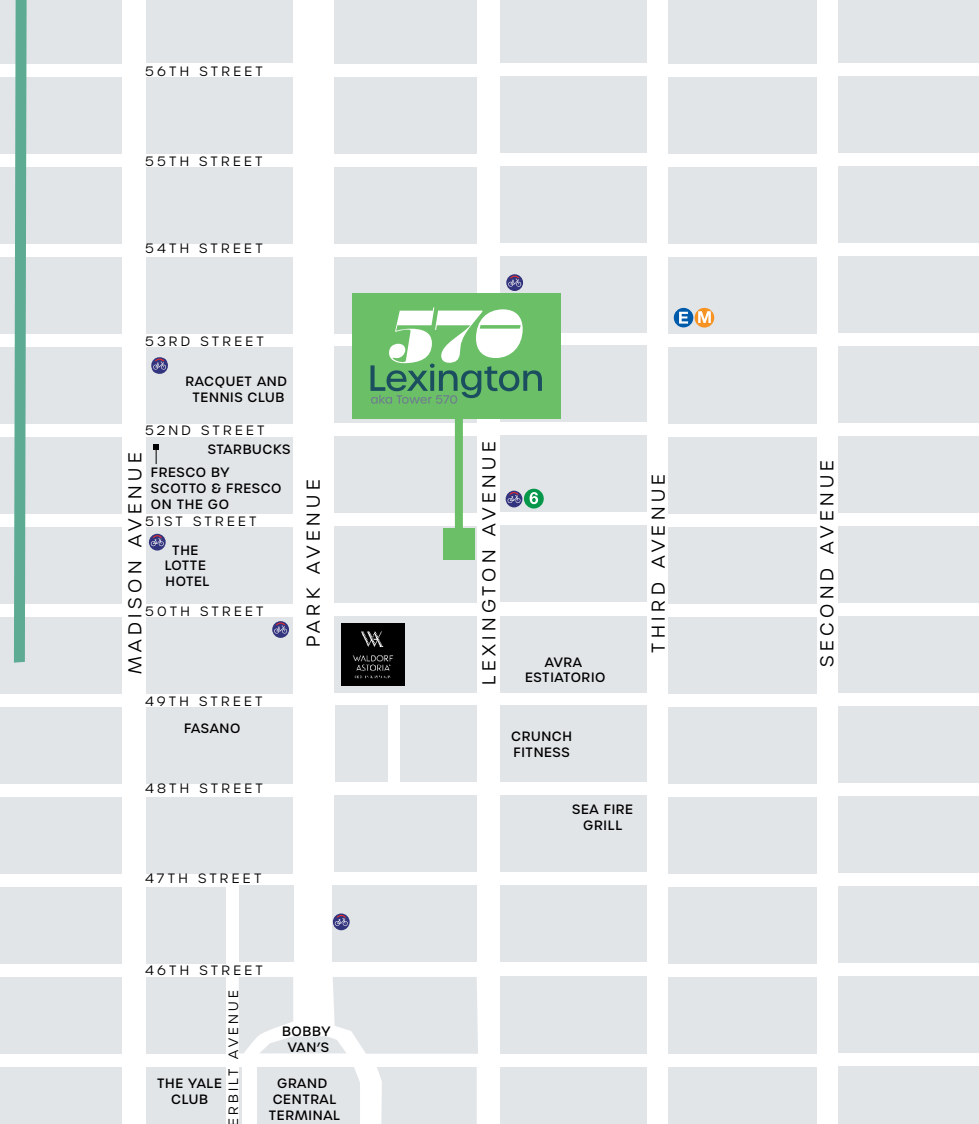

Space highlights

- Possibility to combine with adjacent unit for a total of 14,080 rsf for a full-floor presence with the ability to expand





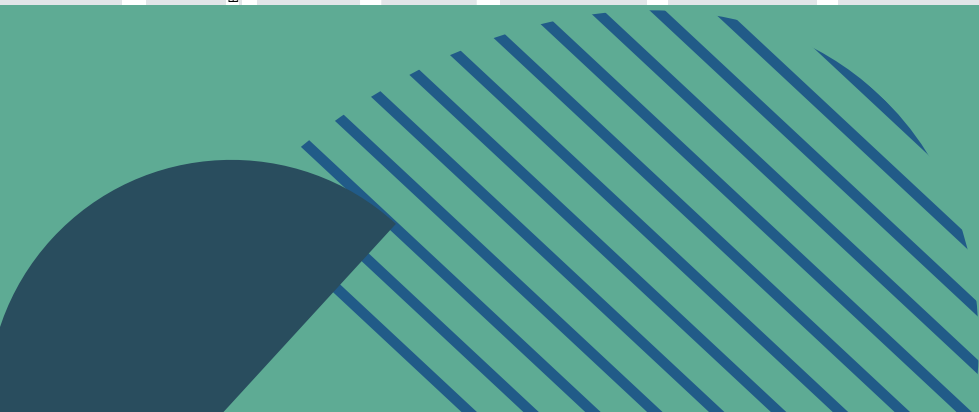
Building description

- Distinctive Art-Deco and landmarked building overlooking Park Avenue, originally built in 1929 to compliment St. Bartholomew's Episcopal Church
- Winner of numerous awards such as BOMA/NY Award for Excellence for Historic Building and the Lucy G. Moses Commercial Project Award and widely recognized as one of the most famous Art-Deco style buildings in New York City

Transportation

- Located adjacent to 51st Street Station which services the 6 train and also provides connections to the Lexington Avenue/53rd Street Station which services the E M lines.
- Less than a 7 minute walk to Grand Central Terminal with access to the following:

- Surrounded by multiple Citi Bike stations
